

## **FCC Course - Arbitrator Training 25-26 June 2012**

The course will provide comprehensive knowledge and guidance on key areas of arbitration proceedings under the FCC Rules.

### **Who should attend**

The course is relevant to all arbitrators, particularly those that did not attend the last training session in 2009, those who wish to develop further knowledge of arbitration proceedings and members aspiring to become arbitrators.

### **What the course will cover**

- Arbitral Institutions - role of the FCC, the Arbitration Act 1996, judicial role of Arbitrators
- English contract law and the English procedural law which governs arbitration where the legal “seat” is within England & Wales
- Arbitration agreement/jurisdiction
- FCC Arbitration and Appeal procedure including time limits
- General Duties and Responsibilities of Arbitrators - and arbitrators’ exercise of discretionary powers
- Potential liability of arbitrators – including arbitrators who resign during the course of proceedings.
- Awards drafting, formal requirements, reasoned awards challenges etc.
- Implications of a defective award on enforcement proceedings
- Practical aspects of arbitration: case study, Q&A
